My name is Samantha. I am 10 years old and in Mme Duggan's Grade 5 class at Lester B. Pearson Public School (French Immersion). I'm going to tell you about a project that I am doing in my class. It is called 'The Nobody Project'. The purpose of this project is that it does not matter if you are small or not as smart as somebody else, you can still make a difference.

How it works is that my class gets a doll named 'Nobody' and each person in our class gets a week with 'Nobody'. We have three choices: we can help people, the environment, or animals. Every person has to attach something onto 'Nobody' to represent what they did. Our class also gets a scrapbook to record what we did. So by the end of the year 'Nobody' is supposed to have become a 'Somebody'.



I have chosen to help people. I decided that I am going to raise money and sponsor children from Africa who are in need of health care, nutrition, and education. Now this is where I need your help. It takes almost \$350 to sponsor a child for one year. So if everyone who gets this magazine gives only \$1 (not everyone in your family, but only \$1 for every house or business), together we could raise enough money to sponsor 200 kids for a year! Every time we get a letter from them I feel so happy that we have sponsored them. If you think about it, \$1 doesn't seem like a lot, right? But when we all work together we can make a huge difference in our world, and it feels so good to know that you have an impact in somebody's life by only giving \$1 of your money. I'm not saying that you have to only give \$1. If you really want to you can give more, but no pressure about having to give more, because it doesn't matter if you give \$1 or \$10 or \$100, you are still helping someone to have a better life.
