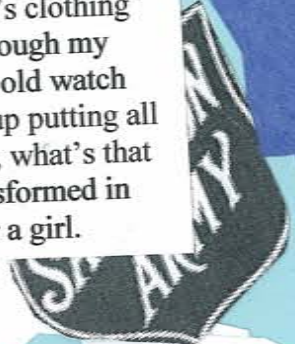
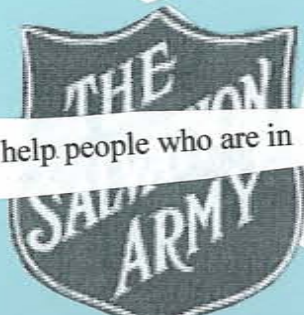
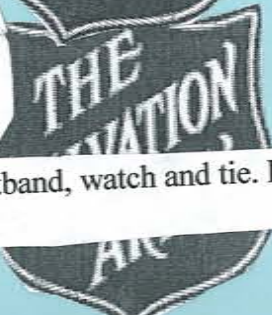
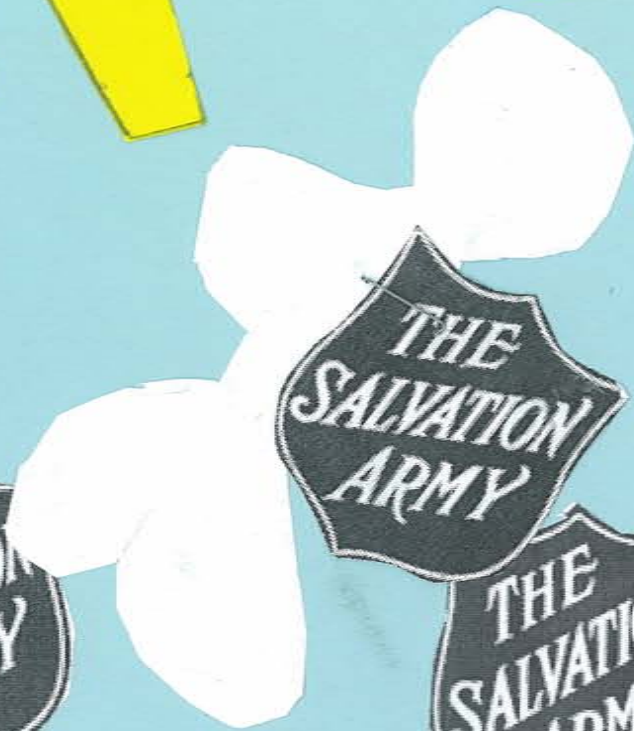


My Experience With Nobody

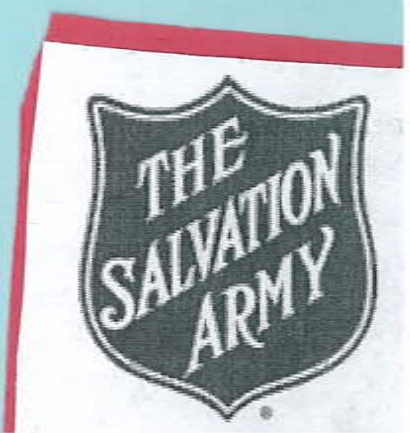
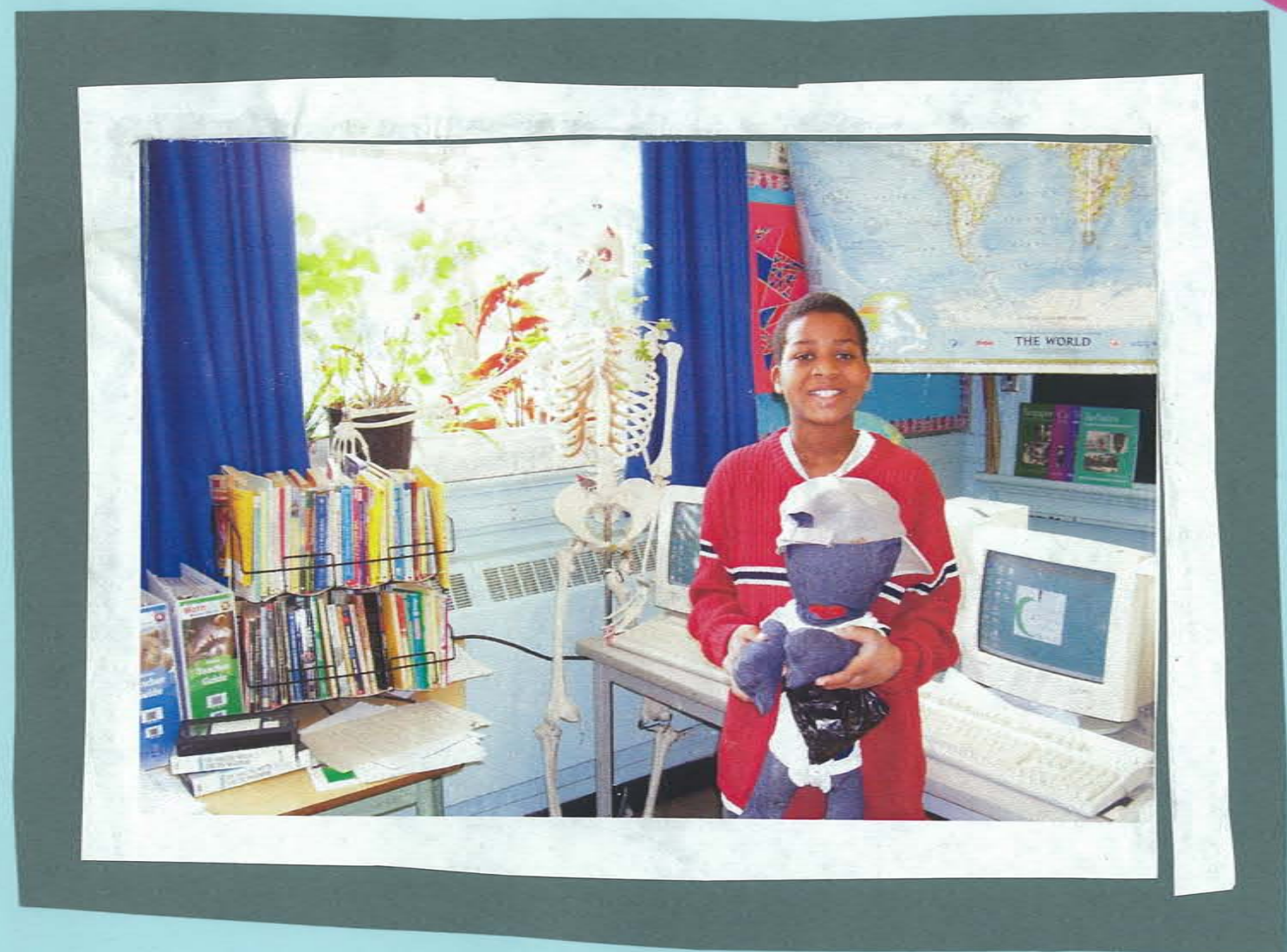
The Little Girl

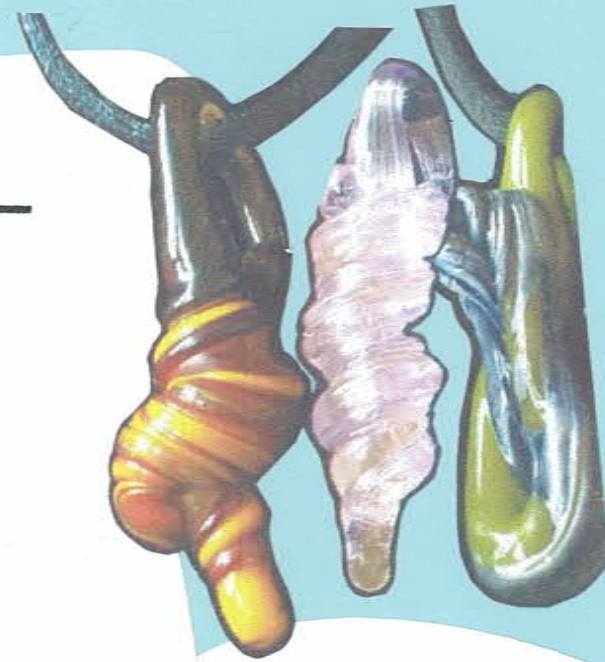

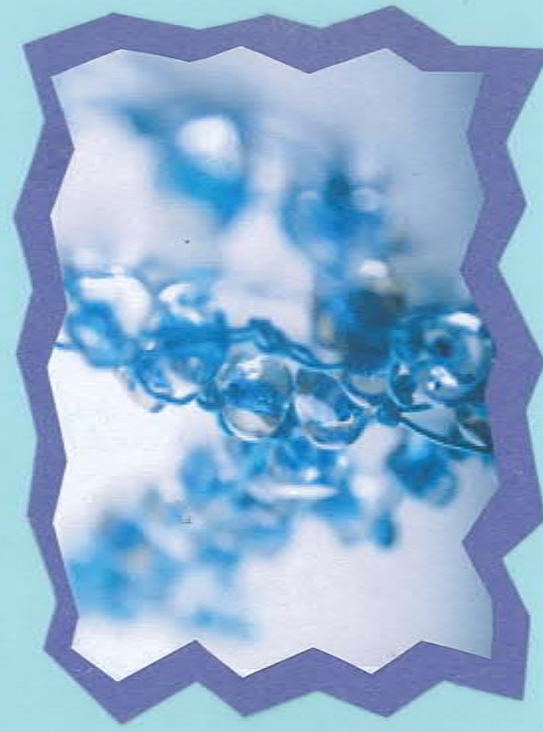

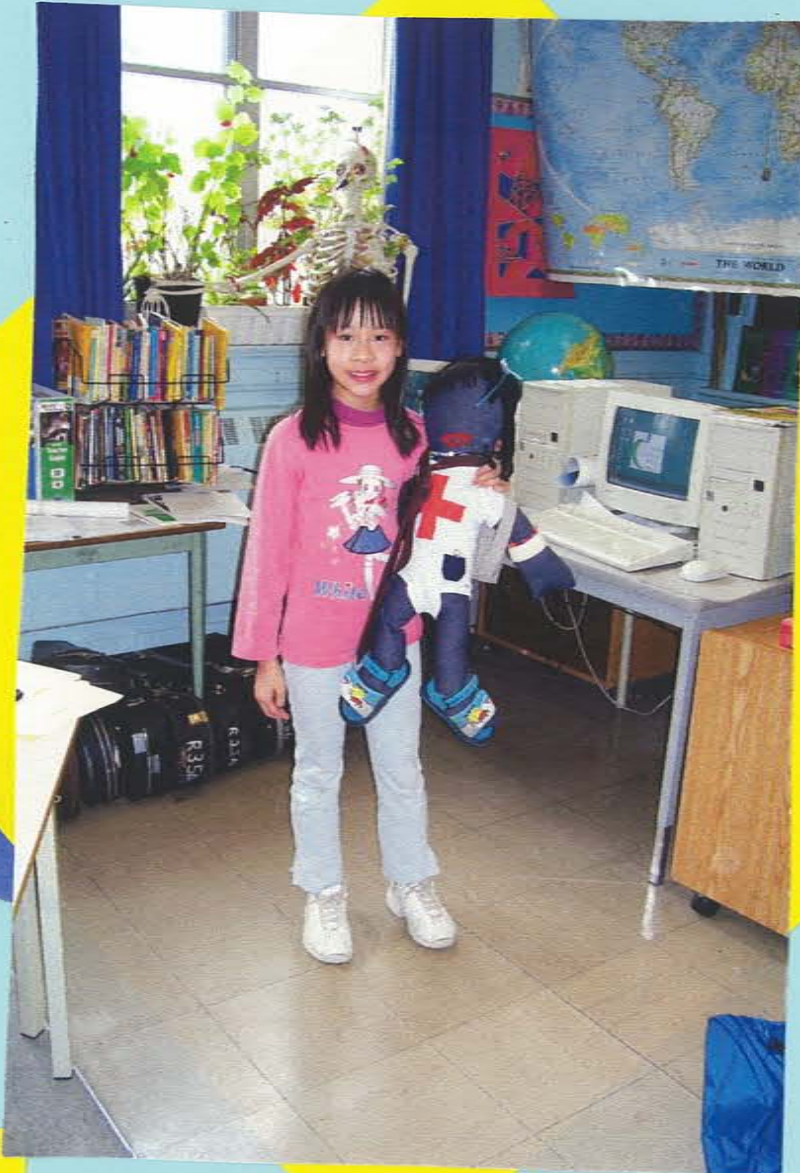

I'm hoping our jewelry sale will be a huge success.

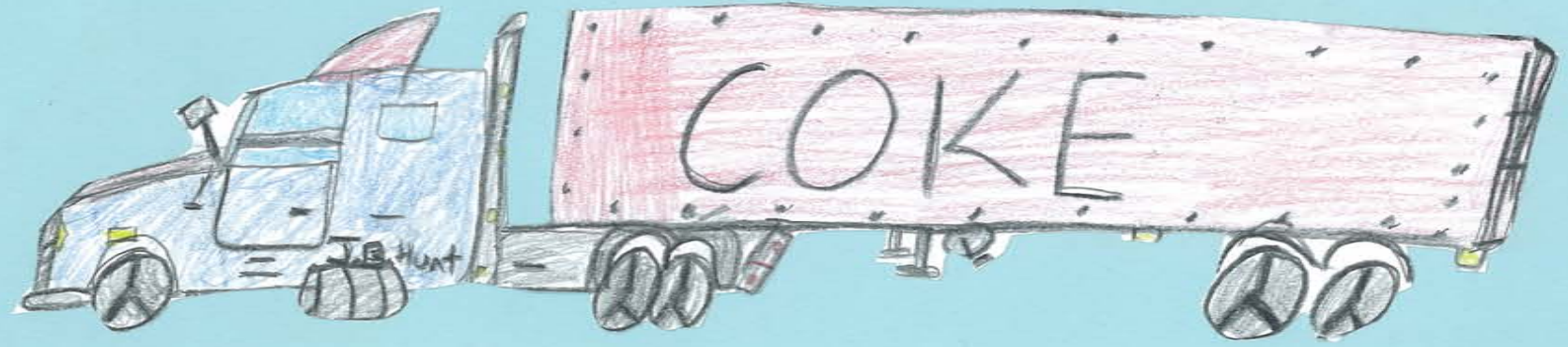

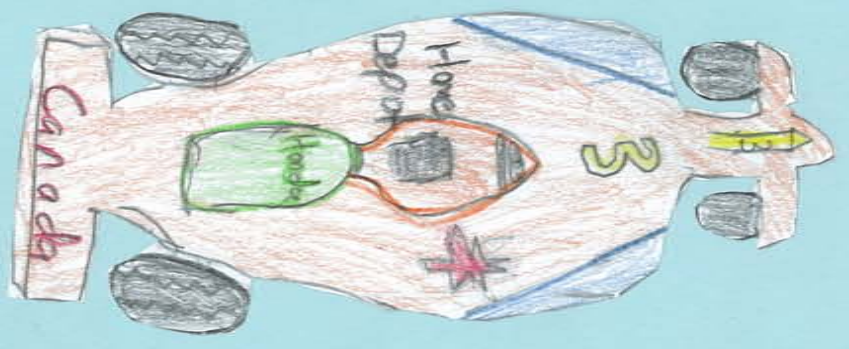
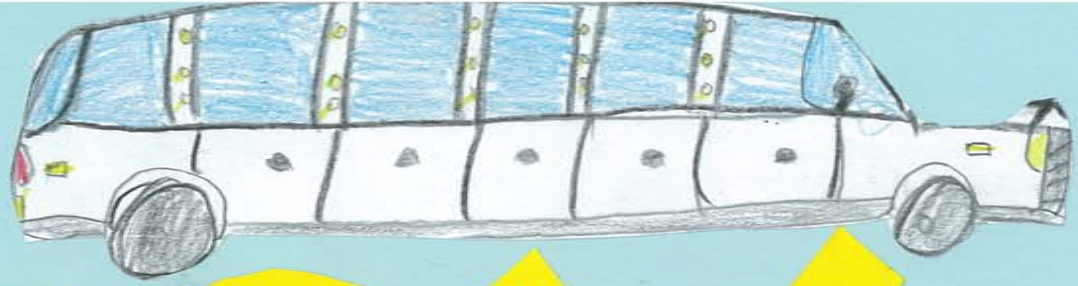
My Nobody Experience

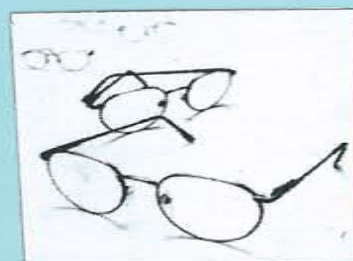
My NOBODY Experience Korina Gov

The Red Cross is made of five, red squares on a white background. It is one of the most recognized emblems but the most poorly understood. What does The Red Cross mean?

The Red Cross began on a battlefield in 1859, in Solferino, Italy. Henry Dunant witnessed the aftermath of a battle that left 40 000 dead or wounded. Henry Dunant organized villagers to help the wounded because there were few military or local medical services. He made sure that victims from both sides of the conflict received water, and medical attention.

In 1864, Dunant and four other Swiss citizens organized an international conference, the First Geneva Convention. The red cross on the white background was a important result of this original conference.

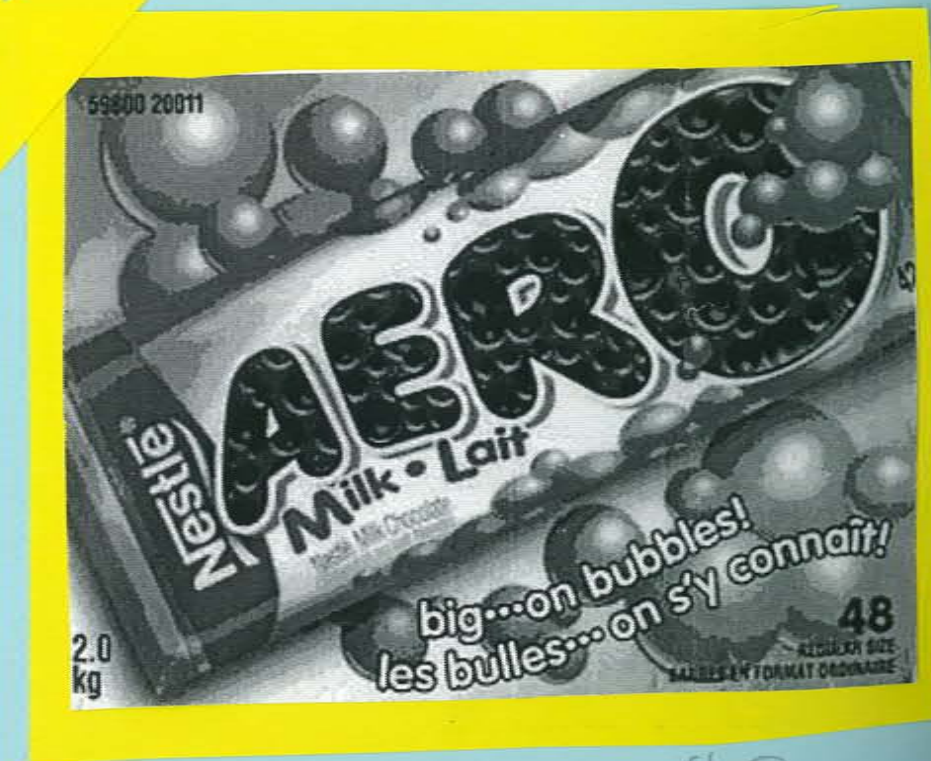
My Experience with Nobody

In response, the administration has agreed to open a formal review process, and is now considering whether to propose federal protections for the bear. Once these crucial safeguards are in place, the administration will be required by law to ensure that any new policy or action does not jeopardize the survival of polar bears or harm their critical habitat.

BioGems Defenders are urging the Bush administration to propose federal protections for the polar bear and are working to safeguard key polar bear habitat in Alaska's Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and Western Arctic Reserve.
